1. That I knew Jane Fletcher late of the Town of Brownsville aforesaid deceased
2. That on or about the third day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seventy two I was present and did see the said Jane Fletcher seal sign and declare a paper writing as and for the Last Will and Testament of the said Jane Fletcher
3. That I and John Keith Galbraith of the Town of Brownsville aforesaid ^{Brownster} did subscribe our names as Witnesses to the execution of the said Will at the request of the said Jane Fletcher and in presence of each other and at the same time and in his presence
4. That the names subscribed as Witnesses to the execution of the said Will are of the proper handwriting of the deponent and the said John Keith Galbraith respectively

This is the Last Will and Testament of me Jane Fletcher wife of John Fletcher the elder of the Town of Bowmanville in the County of Durham Province of Ontario. Never made this third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two as follows.

I Give Devise and Bequeath those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate lying and being in the Town of Bowmanville in the County of Durham and Province of Ontario, containing by admeasurement one hundred and twenty square rods and sixteen square rods being the same more or less and being composed of Town Lots Numbers Five, six and seven in Block W fronting on Church Street in the Town of Bowmanville aforesaid unto my sons David Henry Fletcher, Alexander Fletcher and Joseph Cowan Fletcher their heirs executors administrators and assigns forever share and share alike, to and for their and their own absolute use and benefit according to the nature and quality therof respectively.

And I also Give Devise and Bequeath unto my son David Henry Fletcher this certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Town of Bowmanville in the County of Durham Province of Ontario containing by admeasurement one quarter.

of an acre of land be the same more or less being com-
posed of Town Lot Number Five in Block Number
Thirty one on the Base line and Hunt Street
in Bowmanville aforesaid. And I also give devise
and Bequeath unto my daughter Jane Elizabeth
Nichols lot Number four in Block Number
Thirty one on Hunt Street in the Town of
Bowmanville aforesaid their heirs executors
administrators and assigns forever, To and for
their and their own abso. to use and benefit
according to the nature and quality whereof respect-
ively. And if I the said Jane Fletcher departs
from this life first her ^{or other in} husband is to have his
living from the said two lots on the Base line
and Hunt Street as aforesaid subject only to the
payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary
expenses and the charges of proving and registering
this my Will. And I appoint Gordon Drummond Fletcher
of the Town of Bowmanville and Robert Falls of Hills-
burg township of Cartwright Executors of this my
Will, And I revoke all other Wills.
