I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Ann W. English all my household goods and chattels and all manner of personal property whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated, during her natural life, and after death then it is will that my son Christopher L. English have the horses and wagons, and all other farming utensils, plowshare, of what ever kind, I give and devise unto my beloved wife Ann W. English, all my Real Estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated, during her natural life, and after her death it is my will that her funeral expenses, and a suitable tomb stone be erected to her memory, and paid for from my personal property after the death of my wife Ann W. English, then it is my will that my son Christopher L. English have all on the east side of the road leading by my house to the main roads adjoining lands of Scull English and James T. English also I give unto my son Christopher L. English after the death of my wife Ann W. English all of my right title and interest of said meadows known as the Babcock meadows and lying on the North East side of English Creek, and adjoining John Drake containing thirty acres more or less, also twelve acres more or less the English Meadow Great Egg Harbor River on the North East side and some Sathanal Risley on the east side of tract the remainder to be equally divide with my four children or their heirs.
